1. Discuss the family's initial reactions to the crisis. How are Doug, Kay, Deni Jeff, Logan, and Beth's reactions different? How are they similar?
2. How would you react to such a catastrophe? What would your first plan of action be?
3. Consider Jeff's rebellious night out to his friend Zach's house. What motivation would draw Jeff out in the middle of a dangerous night? How did his parents, Doug and Kay, react?
4. Imagine planning a shopping list for your first trip to the store after the disaster struck. What would be at the top of the list?
5. Who would you turn to in the event of a murderer in your midst? How would your community react?
6. What were some of the initial relationship barriers the Brannings had to work around within the family? When did those barriers begin to break down?
7. Mob mentality breaks down morals and values for many people. What morals and values did the Brannings abandon? Which are worth keeping? How much would you sacrifice to survive?
8. Doug Branning turned to the Bible to find answers, strength and hope. Where in the Bible would you turn during such times of disaster?
9. Hope interweaves Last Light as an important thematic thread. Where do you see hope in the lives of the Brannings and their community? When does hope seem absent?
10. What other common threads tie this book together? Where do you see these threads in different character's lives?
11. Miss Eloise calls suffering a "learned skill." Why would suffering be considered a skill? What aspects of suffering have the Brannings learned from?
12. Discuss the change in Deni's character throughout the book. What smaller events impacted her personality? How do you think she will continue to grow after her experience with Vic Green?
13. God's gifts abound in Last Light. What are some of the less tangible things God provided for the Brannings and their neighbors? What has God provided in your life?
